

CYCU Outreach Ministry Advisory Committee Establishment Guidelines

Article 1

The university, adhering to its founding spirit, establishes the Outreach Ministry Advisory Committee to promote Christian educational work.

Article 2

The Committee consists of 9 to 13 members, appointed by the president, with a term of one year. The president serves as the chairperson, and the director of the Chaplain's Office serves as the executive secretary, also as an ex-officio member.

Article 3

The responsibilities of the Committee are as follows:

1. To uphold and proclaim the university's traditional and orthodox Christian faith based on Biblical truth.
2. To guide the planning and implementation of Christian education.
3. To review the direction and objectives of courses such as "Religious Philosophy" and "Philosophy of Life."
4. Other matters related to evangelistic work.

Article 4

The Committee shall meet once each semester. Special meetings may be convened when necessary.

Article 5

A meeting can be held only if at least two-thirds of the committee members are present. Decisions require the approval of a majority of those present. Relevant individuals may be invited to attend if needed.

Article 6

These guidelines shall be implemented after being approved by the Administrative Meeting and announced by the president. The same procedure applies for any future amendments.
